Pastor and Staff Salaries Update

Equity and fairness are core values for us here at Fairmount Avenue United Methodist Church. The Staff/Parish Relations Committee (SPRC) works hard at maintaining these values for our pastor and staff salaries. At the same time, we are very aware that these items comprise close to two thirds of our annual operating budget. Our pastors and paid staff are a key part of the overall success of our church, and we are grateful for their dedicated service and your generosity as a congregation in supporting them.

In response to the current economic state of affairs in our world we are proposing a 6% cost-of-living increase for all paid staff. We feel this is long overdue and comes much closer to matching the rate of inflation that we have in the past. In addition, we are proposing an additional merit increase, similar to the step raises found in most other pay systems, that reward performance and longevity above and beyond merely keeping pace with rising costs of living. This is a new step for us, but a necessary one in order to offer truly equitable compensation for staff. We ask that you consider this when making your pledging decision for next year.

Due to other variables in the budget process, these proposals will result in a minimal overall increase in the church's operating budget for 2023.

Again, sincere thanks to all for your continuing support for our staff and all of our ministries.
